

We are so happy to be able to welcome you all back to the Boulder Barn from 12th April.

A big thank you to all of you that continue to support us, as a Charity this is even more important so that we are able to continue with our charitable work into the future.

The Boulder Barn has been closely following UK government and Governing Body advice and regulations since the onset of the Covid-19 outbreak. We are continually reviewing our operations and policies and making further adaptations where necessary.

We continue to do all we can to keep our facility safe and will be continuing with our vigorous cleaning regime and monthly sanitisation of the whole building to keep you all safe.

Over lockdown we have re-set over 50 new problems for you to try, ranging in grade from VB all the way to V8+. We also have new holds for you to test yourselves on from Kilter and So iLL.

Our opening hours remain the same but booking for all times is now required, please ensure you call to book your slot as without a booking you may be turned away if we are at full capacity.

10.15am until 9.15pm Monday to Friday

9am until 6pm Saturday and Sunday.

You will still be required to wear a face mask on arrival and at any time within non-climbing areas. This means that you will not need to wear a mask while climbing, using the training area or moving between problems on the boulder matting. This does mean that in any other area or at any other time you will need to wear a face mask to help protect the people around you. You will also see our staff wearing face masks when they are not behind the protective reception screen.

Our cafe will operate on a takeaway basis only, so you can still get our wonderful coffee and cake and enjoy them in our seating area outside.

In addition to wearing masks we politely remind our climbers that the Government slogan – **HANDS, FACE, SPACE** is the best and most effective way to help control the spread of COVID-19.

Regular **hand washing** before, during and after your climb is important; there are plenty of hand sanitiser stations throughout the centre for your use.

Please also keep a **safe distance** from our staff and other climbers (unless they are in your household or 'bubble') whilst in the Boulder Barn.
